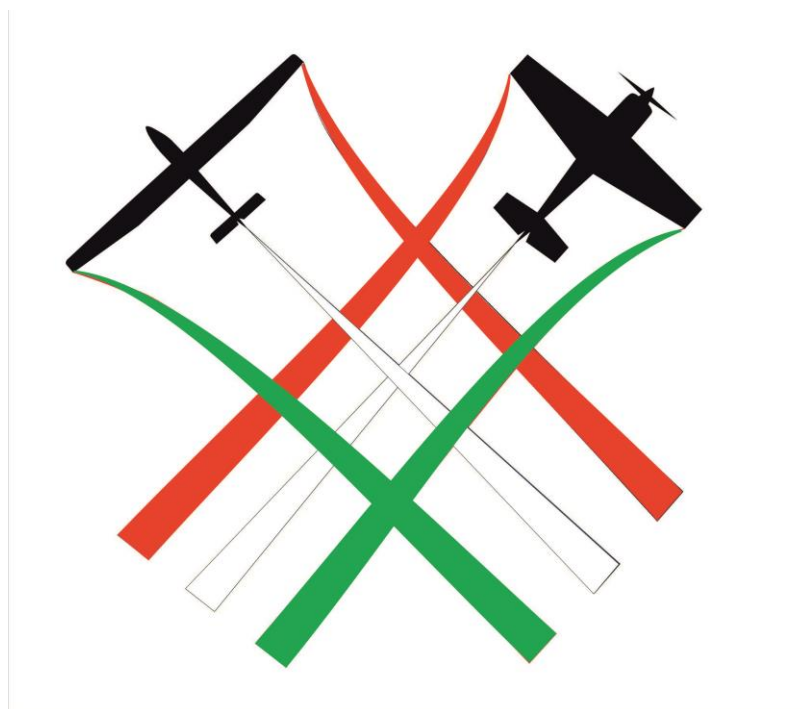

# 1. NATIONAL RULES OF POWERED AEROBATICS, SPORTSMAN CATEGORY

## 1.1. Sportsman category

### 1.2.1 Safety pilot

Competing pilots in Sportsman category could enlist the service of safety pilot by their own decision or by the order of the Jury.

The Organiser ensure the safety pilot for free of charge.

The safety pilot is not authorized to give for the pilot any kind of instructions from liftoff during landing.

If the safety pilot decide to take the control, the competitor will be disqualified from the program.

There is no objection against the decision of the safety pilot.

### 1.2.2 Height limitations

Category	Upper	Lower	Disqualification
SPORTSMAN	1300 m	300 m	200 m

To reduce the upper height limit due to weather conditions in SPORTSMAN category is not permitted.

### 1.2.3 Contest flights in SPORTSMAN category

Known Compulsory, Unknown Compulsory1, Unknown Compulsory 2

The Jury is responsible for composition of Unknown Compulsory programs in SPORTSMAN category without respect of competitor's advice.

The list of allowed figures contains the Appendix Nr.1 of this document.

### 1.2.4 The official Unknown programs must be published to the competitors at least 4 hours prior to its start.

### 1.2.5 Competitors found guilty of violating flight regulations and/or causing a dangerous situation will, on the recommendation of the Jury, be disqualified or ordered to enlist the service of safety pilot by the Contest Director. The Chief Judge may, with the agreement of two-thirds of the Board of Judges, exclude or order to enlist the service of safety pilot a pilot who is not flying safely or could cause an unsafe situation This would apply from takeoff to touchdown. No protest against the decision of the Jury will be accepted.

### 1.2.6 Penalties

- **Time limit for the programmes:** no penalty points are given

- **Infringements of height limits:**

For every obvious and visually recognised infringement of the lower height limit during the performance of Programmes the competitor will be given 100 penalty points.

For an infringement of the upper height limit no penalty points are given.

A competitor flying lower than 200 metres will be disqualified from the current programme for causing a dangerous situation.

- **Interruption of a Programme or Addition of Figures**

A competitor will be given penalty points, in accordance with the appropriate tariff, if he or she interrupts his or her programme:

(a) by dipping the wing three (3) times immediate one after the other;

(b) in order to make a change of attitude or direction between two figures (more than 90°);

(c) in order to lose or regain height;

Following a programme interruption, the competitor must restart his or her programme with the figure)

(a) immediately preceding the point of interruption;

(b) in which the interruption occurred;

(c) immediately following the point of interruption

In no case shall a figure that has already received a score (even if zero) prior to a programme interruption rescored.

Should the competitor restart his or her programme at any point other than provided the competitor will be given additional penalty points in accordance with the appropriate tariff.

The addition of a figure to a sequence will also result in penalty points, but all subsequent figures correctly flown will be marked. For example, if the additional figure flown is a repeat of the previous figure, the score for the original figure must be retained, even if zero. Under no circumstances should a competitor be allowed to gain an advantage due to this additional figure.

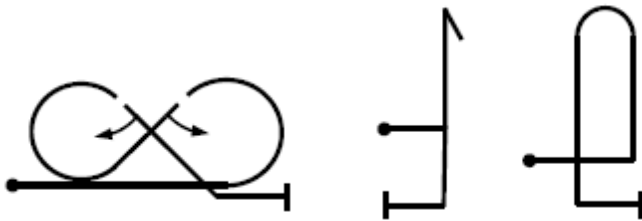
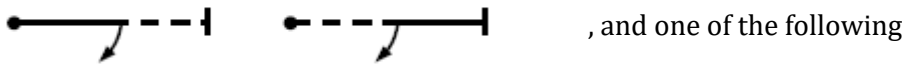
- **Violations of Safety Manoeuvres**

Before the wing-dipping at the start of each competition flight it is compulsory that all

pilots perform safety manoeuvres as follows. These figures may only be flown once, in any order. They must be flown inside the performance zone.

A penalty of 20 points will be given

- a) if no safety manoeuvre will be performed
- b) for each and every figure flown outside the box or other than prescribed manoeuvres

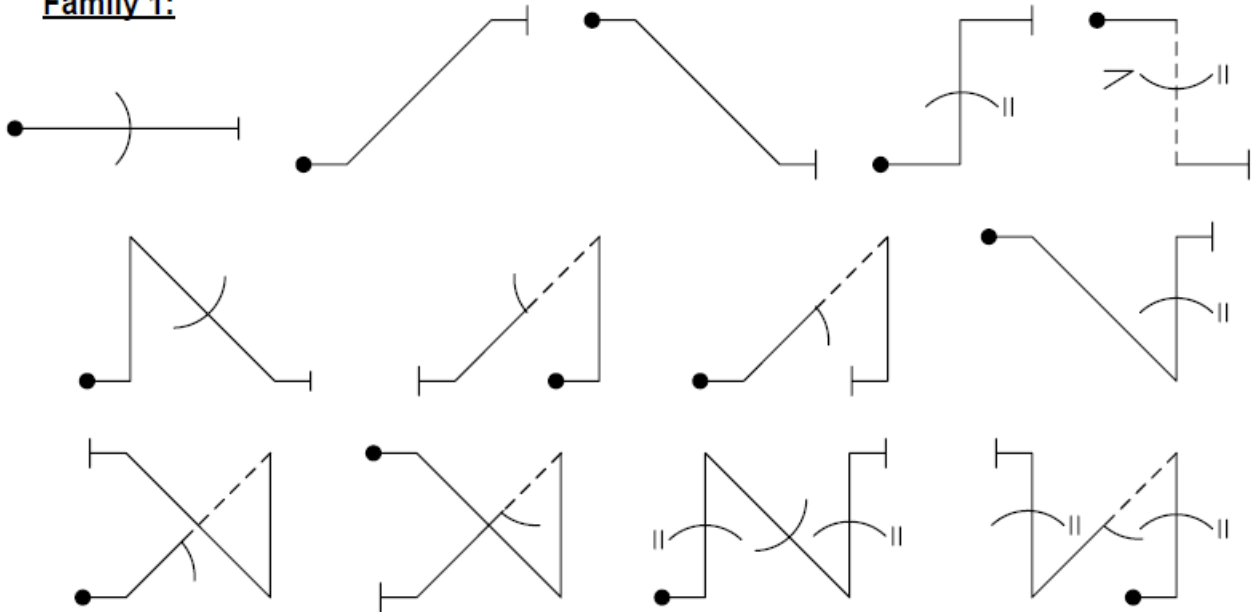


### 1.2.7 Other rules and regulations

Danubia Cup Rulebook is based on the FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 and General Section. The Rulebook contains only specific rule-modifications. All other untouched statements in the FAI Sporting Codes are valid as is.
